Vestas has received an order of 50 MW from Hebei Construction Investment New Energy Company (HCINEC). This order consists of 25 units of 2.0 MW wind turbines, and will be installed at Daqinghe Yanchang wind farm in Laoting County (Hebei province). The wind turbines are scheduled to be delivered in the third quarter of this year.
